District cup dates will be determined after it is determined if CYSA can continue to lease the Morgan Hill complex, and which dates will be available.

Under-10 teams will now be playing in the tournament format rather than jamboree format. Under-9 teams will continue in the jamboree format.

Teddy restated the fees for teams voted on at the January district meeting:

\$400/team for u11 and above

\$250 for u10

\$100 (or maximum allowed by CYSA) for u 9

Teddy proposed holding a spring tournament on June 6 & 7, for under-8 and older spring league teams, at a cost of \$325 per team (with allowable reduced cost for jamboree age groups).

## Spring soccer

George Tharakan proposed three changes to the district 2 spring league rules:

- 1) currently registered (08/09) players may play for multiple district 2 teams, within the same club (not necessarily the same league), as long as the player is not too old for the age group of play
- 2) all district 2 spring team rosters are limited to 26 players
- 3) the maximum number of player playing on any district 2 spring league game is limited to:
  - a) 18 players for u10 (soon-to-be u11) and older teams
  - b) 13 players for u8 & u9 teams

George Tharakan (Spring) motion, Chuck Kluz (Foothill) 2<sup>nd</sup>:

18 in favor, 2 opposed & 2 abstention – motion passes
