1. Meeting called to order by Dave Mann, Commissioner, at 7:40pm.
2. The minutes of the March 2000 meeting were approved.
3. Treasurer's report.
 - Approved
4. Registrar Report
 - Registration materials for 2000/2001 have arrived. League registrar's meeting schedules for Saturday, May 15 at SCU. Jan and Pam have written a registrar's handbook that can be downloaded from the D2 web site. Several forms including a USYSA Player Release form are also available on the web.
 - Reminder: the 4-part green Player transfer form is obsolete and will not be accepted. Use only the 6-part blue form.
 - Jan needs sample signatures from registrars in some leagues.
 - WINreg may be available in June. Is there a league that would like to volunteer to beta test the s/w?
5. Coordinators' Reports
 - 5.1 Disciplinary Committee.
 - The suspension of a D2 coach reported last month was upheld on appeal at the State level. .

5.2 Tournaments

- The tournament calendar should be on the web within 2 weeks.
- The NCAA/Adidas showcase event is tentatively scheduled for Dec 2/3 at Morgan Hill. However State has yet to receive the reservation fee. CIF agreement will be required if High School age teams are to participate and be seen by college coaches present.
- The Mustang classic will be held on second weekend of August (12/13) as in previous years.

5.3. Morgan Hill

- A Petition supporting the purchase of the complex by Morgan City Council is being circulated for signature in Morgan Hill.

5.4. ODP

- 3958 invitations have been mailed to eligible players. Ads have been placed in local newspapers for coaches. Presidents are requested to remind coaches in their leagues about ODP.
- There will be no state teams for U18 or U19.
- Players registering for ODP treys on the day will be required to pay a \$10 late fee.

5.5. State Premier League

- Application forms available on the web. Deadline May 15.
- Mel Dutra made the motion that "District 2 will pay half the registration fee (\$300) for all teams registering in District 2". Seconded by Martin von Raesfeld.
Motion approved 15-0.
- Mel encourages leagues to pay the other half of the registration fee.
- The Premier league will have its own disciplinary committee.

 - Each league president is asked to identify where in their League's Constitution and Bylaws certain CYSA mandatory items appear. Dave distributed a checklist of the required items and asks for an updated copy of Constitution and Bylaws to be forward to him.
 - Do not send registered packages or overnight mail to Dave's house. Nobody is there to sign for it during the day and Dave will not make more than one trip to the Post Office per week! Use regular mail please.
