1. Meeting called to order by Dave Mann, Commissioner, at 7:30 PM.
2. The minutes of the March 2001 meeting were approved.
3. Treasurer's report.
 - Total income and expenses were reported and Treasurer's report was distributed.
 - Current total assets - \$230,540.72.
 - If you need an expense form, call or email Paul and he can email you the form.
4. Registrar's Report
 - There are 4 different booklets this year for registration. The Information for Coaches booklets were distributed. The district will not print copies for every coach, leagues should do that. The booklets will be posted on the web at some point.
 - All registrars should be on WinReg now.
 - More registration forms need to be ordered from CYSA. All have been distributed to league registrars.
5. Coordinators' Reports
 - 5.1 Disciplinary Committee.
 - Red card report was distributed. Two incidents are being reviewed by the state PAD committee.
 - The District PAD committee membership was reviewed. Dave would like to add one non-board member to the PAD committee so if anyone has someone interested, please contact Dan Pereira.

5.2 Tournaments

- Tournament calendar comes out on Sunday and will be posed on the CYSA web site.
- All old travel papers need to be thrown away. Effective now, you must use the new travel papers and all required signatures must be provided before sending to Wendy. The forms are available only from Wendy. If Wendy is unavailable, get the form from Jan Gates. The entire procedure will be available on the D2 web site's Tournament page.

5.3. Morgan Hill / San Martin

- For Sale signs have gone up at Morgan Hill but we have a contract for another year.
- Nothing new on San Martin - waiting for signatures.

5.4. ODP

- Tryouts coming up 5/5-6 and 5/12-13.
- Fewer coaching applicants this year but higher quality.
- Applications are coming in – expect about 600. Application price goes up after 4/15. Advanced registration helps us a lot with organization. Please encourage kids to apply in advance.

5.5. State Premier League

- Apps are due on 5/11 at 5:00pm. Applications are on the CYSA web site. All the rules and regulations are there as well.

5.6. Abronzino Playing League.

- Expecting projection of teams on 5/7 from leagues. So, leagues please bring this information to the next Abronzino meeting.
- Team applications are due to the Abronzino on July 1st this year.

5.7. C3PL

- No report

5.8. Coaching

- The league coaching director list was passed around for validation by the league presidents.
- E/D course at Castro Middle school – details are on the District II web site and also on the CYSA web site. This course is a prerequisite for the State D course.
- There are still 15 slots available for the State D course in July. (July 18-22 at UOP in Stockton.) Prerequisites are the E/D license and the referee course.
- District IV is now requiring at least an F license for Class I coaching. Dave suggested that leagues consider setting some coach licensing standards and he would like to see a District II standard. Lorraine will come up with a plan for the next meeting and it will be voted on. Part of this proposal may be to require Class I and Class III coaches to take first aid and CPR training.

5.9. Association Cup

- Discussion for making A-cup an open cup next year. The U16 and U19 were this year and it worked well. All age groups will be limited to 64 teams next year. With this limit, most teams that want to play A-cup will be able to. Each district will be guaranteed at least 3 spots in every age group. These are just proposals being made to the CYSA Board.
- Also recommending an 8-day waiting period for paperwork – again, just a proposal at this point.

5.10. State Cup

- S-cup running smoothly.

5.11. District Cup.

- Fields have been reserved. A committee has been formed and Ana Kielbasa will be handling registration and referee funds.
- 5 leagues have committed to hosting.

- Still looking for someone to organize pins and trophies.
- Also wants a referee coordinator to help if referees get into a bind.

5.12. Spring Soccer

- 320 teams registered. Most of growth is in U8-U13. This is a 25% growth over last year.
- Expect \$22k profit.
- Tournament this year will be done on a distributed basis – multiple sites. Intend to give t-shirts to U10 and younger teams, which are run in a jamboree format. The Spring tournament will run at a slight loss as a result.
- Jeff Figone is the red card coordinator for Spring. Passes will be held for some number of weeks and then mailed back to the primary contact.

5.13 Referee

- No report.

5.14 Communications.

- CYSA Web Site was moved to a new service at the beginning of the month. Appearance to users should be almost the same. Advantage to CYSA is double the disk space, programmability and half the monthly cost.

5.15 Risk Management

- Will be investigating if we can make first aid and CPR training mandatory for all Class I and Class III coaches.

6. Commissioner's Report

- No board meeting last month.
- Most leagues have signed the district inter-league release agreement. This agreement has replaced the mountain of largely useless inter-league release paperwork we used to generate.

8. New Business

- Jim Adams proposes changing his league from the Sunnyvale Alliance Youth Soccer League to the Foothill Youth Soccer League. Second by Bill Davilla. Approved Unanimously.
- Almaden implemented a “constructive sideline” policy. Coaches, parents and players sign a form pledging to eliminate all non-constructive comments to players and referees. Mike Chavez will send a copy of the form to all league presidents.
