2. The minutes of the April 2000 meeting were approved.
3. Treasurer's report.
 - Still have 6 teams that have not paid from association cup.
 - The treasurer's report was approved
4. Registrar Report
 - Inter-league release waiver list for District 2 - missing just 4 league signatures.
 - New national forms are available – waiver for under-17 and clearance form for over-17. These forms are available on the District web site.
 - May be a new registration program by the end of the month that everyone will need to convert to.
 - New registration booklet available from Jan. Copies were distributed at the meeting
5. Coordinators' Reports
 - 5.1 Disciplinary Committee.
 - New red card report distributed.

5.2 Tournaments

- State tournament meeting this Sat
- Jamborees – usually kept within district. If you want to post a jamboree, you need the approval of either the district tournament coordinator or district commissioner.

5.3. Morgan Hill

- The mayor of MH wants to have a meeting to discuss soccer fields.
- New San Martin contract is going before the board this weekend.

5.4. ODP

- First tryouts last weekend. Numbers look good.

5.5. Referees

- Go to D2RA.com for referee clinics.

5.6. State Premier League

- Monday (5/15) is the last day for applications.

5.6. Abronzino Playing League

- Have collected preliminary info on numbers of teams expected from every league except Orchard Valley.
- Looking for a new Treasurer.
- Boys U13-U15 age groups will be limited to 22 teams each – looking very full based on preliminary estimates
- 7/10/00 will be the final meeting for divisional assignments – applications must be in by then
- Mandatory Coaches Meeting – sometime in early September, not finalized yet.
- Team Fee increased to \$70
- U17-U19 boys and girls teams also pay \$360 referee fee. These are the only age groups that will play at Morgan Hill

5.7. C3PL

- Application deadline is 7/31/00. 7/27 is the final reps meeting so hoping to have most applications in by then.
- Registering teams must provide a copy of the team goldenrod.
- Registration Fees holding at \$65 per team. Requesting that leagues pay the team registration fees instead of individual coaches.
- Just like Abronzino, this year C3PL games will have coaches/player on one side of the field and spectators on the opposite side of the field.
- Staying with the policy of game times/locations must be communicated to opponent no later than the Monday preceding the game.
- Working on an automated scoring system, same as Abronzino.
- Working on arranging coaching clinics for Class 3 coaches.
- Shooting to have schedules out by 8/15.

5.8. Recreational Playing League

- Still looking for a volunteer to organize this effort for Fall.
- Tom Quirk and Lee Gazlay are working on a web-based registration facility for U14-U19 players.

5.9. Coaching

- Current courses are posted on the D2 web site. More courses are on the way.

5.10. Association Cup

- Donnell is attending the CYSA Association Cup meeting this weekend but we are still looking for a new District Association Cup coordinator.

5.11. State Cup

- D2 had 5 teams in finals. Congratulations to the DeAnza Sharks and Santa Clara Sonics who were champions in their age groups.

- Rules & Regulations have been distributed.
- Looking for more participation from leagues.
- Some teams have already signed up.
- Artwork for new tournament pin is completed.
- Motion by Pereira to host a D-Cup playday for U10 teams partially underwritten by District II. Teams would pay \$50 and District II would make up the difference. Second by Gallegos. Apporved.

- Should show a profit of about \$20k.
- Web hosting fees going up to about \$135 per month due to increased activity.
