1. Meeting called to order by Dave Mann, Commissioner, at 7:41pm.
2. The minutes of the June 2000 meeting were approved.
3. Treasurer's report.
 - Approved
 - All scholarship requests for the 2000/2001 season should be submitted on the Scholarship application form available from Paul. Leagues must get their applications in within 2 weeks for Dave's consideration and approval.
4. Registrar Report
 - A schedule of monies owed or to be refunded by league for the 1999/2000 season was distributed. The gap between D2 and State records has narrowed to 201 players.
 - A new Guest Player form is to be used for out of State tournaments. The old form can still be used for CYSA-N tournaments. Note that a 3 guest player limit applies in CYSA-N. Limit out of State is greater. All required signatures must be present before Dave will sign. Allow plenty of time.
 - All players Ids must be entered on travel papers. Player signature is optional.
 - Max number of players per U10 team is 13 (one player fewer than USYSA allows). This is documented in the CYSA-N team manual. Leagues are encouraged to monitor U10 teams to

ensure that 50% playing time per player per game is achieved. A motion that all U10 teams in D2 should be allowed to roster 14 players was made by Dan Minutello and seconded by Paul Vargas. Only league presidents voted. **Motion defeated 4-7.**

A motion to allow the U10 Phoenix team from Almaden YSL to roster 14 players was made by Paul Gallegos and seconded by Bob Joyce. **Motion defeated 4-7**

- Birth certificates are being examined more closely this year to ensure that the issuing authority's verification stamp and date are present.
- The International Clearance form is required for every player 14 years of age and older entering the USA. If USYSA clearance is not given within 3 weeks, a temporary clearance can be obtained.

5 Coordinators' Reports

5.1 Disciplinary Committee..

- An incident of referee assault that occurred in Almaden involving a Redwood team is being investigated by the State.

5.2 Tournaments

- The process is going well. Rejection letters need to be forwarded to Wendy within 7 days of receipt.
- It seems difficult to balance the number of available tournaments per age per class with the number of teams seeking a tournament. Redwood recently cancelled a tournament due to lack of applications received by the mandated deadline. Following cancellation, they received a flood of applications from teams that had been rejected from other tournaments the same weekend. This is an issue and perhaps requires some co-ordination between tournament directors.
- Ed Villalpando's 3v3 tournament was a great success.

5.3. Morgan Hill

- "Still a mess". The problem is low water pressure. Hope to be ready for August tournament..

5.4. ODP

- Dave thanked Jack Salvemini and his committee members for a job well done.
- All teams have been formed and are doing well.

5.5. State Premier League

- The schedules are out. Goldenrods to be sent to State by **July 14** else team will be fined.
- There are State Premier games scheduled on the CYSA sanctioned tournament weekend in October.

5.6. Abronzino Playing League.

- The teams and brackets are now known. Watch the web for details.
- Don't forget the mandatory meeting for all Abronzino coaches scheduled for **Thurs Sept 7** else you will begin the season with a **minus 3 point** handicap !!

5.7. C3PL

- The plan is to use MJ's Spring League web based programs for C3PL.
- The coaching clinics will run every Wednesday and Saturday through July. They are highly recommended and free. See web for details.
- C3PL needs all coach's e-mail addresses.

5.8. Coaching

- Seven F and two E classes are scheduled. See web.
- 9 months must elapse after completing one level before the next level can be taken. Every new coach must start with the F class. Skipping a level requires CYSA approval.
- Duplicate license cards can be obtained from CYSA via the web for \$10.

5.9. Association Cup

- Dan will fill in until a volunteer can be found. Dave stated that D2 teams could suffer if a volunteer cannot be found.

5.10. State Cup

- The regional winners in U14 and U15 in 2001 will all be able to advance to Nationals for the first time in these age groups.
- 2001 Regionals - Albuquerque. 2001 Nationals - Long Island.

5.11. District Cup.

- Register on-line. Rules and requirements are on the web. Go to <http://www.cysadistrict2.org/> and click on the District 2 Cup under Tournaments on the left side of the page.
- The list of leagues that have signed up to host different age groups still has a few gaps. It was suggested that class 4 categories for U11, U13 and U15 could be removed.
- Team registration deadlines are U14-U19 Aug 7, U11-U13 Sept 18. Teams registering after these dates will be rejected.
- Leagues are reminded that in order to have their teams play, they must sign up to host part of the tournament. Dave stated that leagues not supporting the District Cup, should not expect their teams to play.

5.13. Recreation

- Dave thanked Steve Wincor for his contributions to D2 and wished him success in his new position as Long Range Planning Co-ordinator for CYSA-N
- Volunteer required .

5.14. Recreational Playing League

- Teams and players are registering. Contact Lezlie Eidson or Paul Vargas.

5.15. Referees

- Referees chosen to officiate at Nationals this year include Jason Scholl and James Mayes from D2.
- Bob Joyce volunteered to manage Morgan Hill field assignments and post the information on the web for referees to access. Thus referees will know in advance which fields are Abonzino, which are State Premier etc.
- The 6-sec goalie rule is now in effect. Other changes grant additional powers to the Assistant Referees to make calls on the field..

6. Commissioner's Report

- The Association Cup is being split into separate class 3 and class 4 competitions. A new cup called the Tide Cup is being introduced next year.
- Team manuals for 2000/2001 and game cards will soon be available.
- Lee Gazlay is advising State with regard to web issues.
- PIM-00 2 will clarify the status of players who wear casts in games. Dave commented that coaches should use common sense and get a Doctor's release before allowing players to play or practice with any cast.
- Released players who subsequently decide to transfer must first rejoin their original team.
- The Marina League is in bad standing with CYSA. Its voting privileges within D2 are suspended
- San Martin is moving ahead but slowly. It is proposed to hire a professional to manage the complex. A permit has been applied for.
- Miguel Silva and Javier Hill have advanced from the Regional pool to the National pool.
- Presidents are encouraged to pass every bit of information down to their coaches.
