1. The meeting was called to order by Dan Pereira, Assistant Commissioner at 7:45.
2. The representatives from San Jose State University asked for D2 to support their men's soccer program by e-mailing the SJSU President and explaining how important the program is.
3. The minutes of the June 2001 meeting were approved.
4. Treasurer's report.
 - The district's accounts are in good order.
 - Abronzino fees are dues from the following leagues: Foothill, Los Gatos, Orchard Valley. Failure to pay may result in those leagues's teams being dropped.
5. Registrar's report.
 - Teams should apply for travel papers when they send in the tournament application.
 - Use either all season 2000/1 CYSA player numbers or all season 2001/2 numbers. A team with mixed player credentials is not valid.
 - Player count reconciliation between D2 and State is still out by 700 players
 - Please don't ask Lezlie's family members registration questions, they don't know the answers!
6. Coordinator's Reports.
 - 6.1 Disciplinary Committee
 - Several cases have been returned to their league for action.
 - 6.2 Tournaments
 - Check the web for tournaments still looking for teams. Also note that acceptance and rejection notification lists are now on the web.
 - The Santa Cruz tournament is closed.
 - 6.3 Morgan Hill Complex
 - The State is now aware of the situation at Morgan Hill thanks to Bob Joyce.
 - 6.4 ODP
 - Going smoothly.

6.5 Referees

- A new law coming from USSF in July will require referees to treat shirt pulling as misconduct (yellow card), not a foul. Such conduct is getting more common and USSF would like to see it stopped.
- Players who are bleeding must leave the field for treatment and can only return after examination by the center referee or an official designated by the center referee.

6.6 State playing league

- The schedule is out. Girls will play at UOP, boys at Morgan Hill. Four fields have been reserved for every playing weekend except Sept 22/23 which is the District Cup weekend. Referees for the Morgan Hill games need to be resolved.
- District 2 has the following teams in the State Playing League, 4 * U16B, 4 * U17B, 4 * U18B, 2 * U16G, 2 * U17G and 1 * U18G.

6.7 Abronzino Playing League

- Mandatory meeting at the same location as last year (Brass Rail, SCU) at 7:30 on Sept 4. Each team must send a representative who has a pass associated with that team.
- Teams must pay referee fees (U17 – U19) and Abronzino registration fees or they will be dropped.

- Registration is underway and 50% complete.
