1. Meeting called to order by Dave Mann, Commissioner, at 7:34 pm.
2. The minutes of the August 2000 meeting were approved.
3. Treasurer's report.
  - Plenty of money – \$223k in the bank. We are probably one of the top districts in the state in terms of our financial position.
  - Fiscal year for CYSA ended 8/31. Need any outstanding expense reports in by the end of this week.
4. Registrar Report
  - Electronic registration to the state is almost done. Still some problems w/ Santa Cruz.
  - CYSA Registrar's Admin has resigned. (text amended 10 Oct 2000)
  - Still expecting money from a few leagues.
5. Coordinators' Reports
  - 5.1 Disciplinary Committee..
    - Disciplinary Committee reviewed two new incidents. One case for poaching and an appeal case.

- In Spring League, a coach who abused a referee received a 2-year suspension. Big message – don't touch a referee. You will receive at least a 2-year suspension and maybe jail time.
- The red card report was distributed. Teams need to remember that with 8 red cards per team, the team is removed from Abronzino.
- There is a 7-10 day turn-around for red cards. Don't call Dave or Dan. Dave has an idea to put red card processing status on the web. Dave, Dan and Lee will work out a mechanism.

#### 5.2 Tournaments

- November 1 is the deadline for paperwork for next year's tournaments. See Wendy for paperwork.
- One tournament allowed a team to play without player passes. Under no circumstances should players be allowed to play without player passes.

#### 5.3. Morgan Hill

- Grass is starting to return at Morgan Hill Soccer Complex.
- Morgan Hill made an offer to purchase the current Morgan Hill Soccer Complex which was rejected by the current owners.
- We have 6 months to make progress on San Martin. CYSA won't allocate money without a business plan. Proposal for District 2 to front money to develop the business plan and obtain use permits. Estimate of costs is \$25k. Motion passed unanimously.

#### 5.4. ODP

- First play day last Sunday for boys. Several games did not have referees. Girls play day is this coming Sunday.
- Artie Cairel & Phil Wright are new ODP technical directors.
- Next year, only one U14 & U15 team will be sent to regional camps.
- Pool of 36-40 kits will train and travel.
- CYSA-N will host Adidas Cup, end of May, 2001.

- 216 teams were represented at last Thursday's required meeting. Only 2 teams were missing.
