1. Meeting called to order by Dave Mann, Commissioner, at 7:40 PM.
2. Christine Bird, Director of Marketing for WUSA, and Marlene Bjornsrud , General Manager of the CyberRays, introduced D2 to the recently formed Women's Soccer league and the Bay Area's local team, the CyberRays. The CyberRays which includes Brandi Chastain on its roster, plans to use Spartan Stadium for all its home games. A flyer was distributed. See: www.bayareacyberrays.com
3. The minutes of the October 2000 meeting were approved..
4. Treasurer's report.
 - The district accounts are in good order.
5. Registrar's Report
 - Jan distributed the latest statement of monies owed by each league for registration.
 - A list of the roster freeze date for teams playing State Cup was distributed. Teams are warned that their roster must include 9 players from the original Fall team to qualify. Checkin rules will be strictly enforced.

5 Coordinators' Reports

5.1 Disciplinary Committee.

- One recent cases involved poaching, another a coach reneged on his promise to place a player on his team. Two other cases were appealed to the State but the District 2 decisions were upheld. Dave suggests that leagues should have their own Disciplinary Committee so that problems can be dealt with at the league level.

5.2 Tournaments

- D2 applications to host tournaments are being submitted to the State next week. PA Tall Trees have 3 days if they want to get their application in for this year
- The State is hosting a training session for new Tournament Directors. The cost is \$100.
- Morgan Hill should still be quoted as the tournament venue.

5.3. Morgan Hill

- A San Martin topographical study is complete. A drawing of the field layout will be available at the next meeting. Steve Wincor is co-ordinating the paper work for San Martin.

5.4. ODP

- No report.

5.5. State Premier League

- Four boys' teams from D2 are in the championship games this weekend in CAL-S. No girls' teams from the district are attending.

5.6. Abronzino Playing League.

- League games for U14 and older are complete. Hosting older teams at Morgan Hill worked well. There were more issues with the younger teams than the older teams this year.
- 6 protests have been received. Only 2 coaches received red cards. Half the number of players received red cards compared to last year.
- Last minute cancellations due to PSAT still result in a forfeit if the referees show up for the game. Note that only the Abronzino Board can declare a game forfeit.
- Both team's parents on the same side of the field has almost resulted in a fight but this is better than expecting the coach to be able to keep the 'adults' under control.
- Neither Abronzino nor C3PL can have bank accounts according to CYSA. All monies must be turned over to the District Treasurer.
- Relegation will occur. Leagues and Abronzino must confirm that significant changes are made to such teams including name change, before they are allowed back. Continually losing teams don't have fun and nor do their opponents.

5.7. C3PL

- 26 send offs this season. Trophies will be distributed this Thursday.
- Recording scores on the web is working well.

5.8. Coaching

- Successful meeting with Karl Dewazien for 30 coaching directors held on Nov 13.
- Tell Lorraine if your league or club appoints a new coaching director..
- Each league needs to schedule one coaching class per season.
- The district needs the names and a brief bio of 2 coaches to be nominated as coach of the year. Mail resumes to Dave and Lorraine.

5.9. Association Cup

- Note the rules for Association Cup qualification on the web or in last month's minutes. Even District Cup winners must apply to qualify.

5.10. State Cup

- One D2 league is in bad standing with CYSA and therefore cannot participate in State Cup.
- Bad checks will cause your State Cup application to be rejected.
- Younger age groups draw is on Dec 3. Dave has a list of the teams who've entered.
- Be prepared for a thorough checkin before leaving the district.

5.11. District Cup.

- Max number of teams at Morgan Hill is 72. No game can start before 9am. to comply with City of Morgan Hill mandate.
- 36 teams are being hosted in Salinas. More assistant referees wanted.
- Ed will provide Paul with a list of those teams that did not pay their District Cup entrance fee. Paul will bill the team's league to recover the money.
- Referee fee for 11 a-side \$20 per official. Fee for U10 also \$20 but club lines must be provided.
- Ed and Roy will supply game schedule to Lee for posting to the web by Nov 24
- A phone number for coaches to call in the event of a possible rainout must be provided for the Salinas fields.

5.12. Spring Soccer

- Increases in popularity every year
- A motion was made by MJ and seconded by Mike Dickinson that "Older age group U10 teams be allowed to play 11 v 11 in the Spring League". **Motion approved 18-0**
- A motion was made by MJ and seconded by Bob Joyce that "District 1 teams be allowed to participate in District 2 Spring soccer except that their U10 players must play 8 v 8". **Motion approved 17-1.**
- Note that spring passes cannot be used outside District 2..

5.13. Recreation Playing League.

- 5 U16B teams and 5 U16G teams were fielded. On line registration not warranted but some sign up information on the web would be useful.

- CYSA is searching for names to replace the class 1, 2 and 4 designations. (Gold silver bronze?)
- Jamborees are out of control. Guidelines will be issued by CYSA
- The ODP coaches have been conditionally approved. Note that there are restrictions as to which ages a coach may coach after his ODP year is over.
- The AGM expects 130 booths. Dave will provide 2 lunch tickets for every board member and league president. CYSA will only pay for rooms where that Board member has a committee meeting in the evening. League presidents must pay for their own rooms.
- CYSA minutes will soon be available on the web.
