1. Meeting called to order by Dick Mussallem, Assistant Commissioner, at 7:45pm. Apologies for absence were received from Jeff Stanga and Melinda Rainville.
2. The March 99 minutes were approved as submitted.
3. Treasurer's Report.

4. Registrar's Report
Jan requires final export disks for 98/99 registered players by May 1.
A list of league registrars is available from Jan. The Interleague Release agreement signed by all presidents will be mailed out this month.
The 98/99 season Player Transfer form is 4 part and green. The 99/00 version is 6 part and blue so press hard because the coach gets copy 6.
The last registrar's training session is in Hollister. Call Jan for details.
5. Coordinators' Reports
 - 5.1. Morgan Hill.
The fields are in great shape. Negotiations for the San Martin complex are being handled by Jeff Stanga and Jeff Allen who are evaluating the proposed lease and preparing a response.
Morgan Hill rental applications are available from Dick Mussallem.
 - 5.2. State Playing League.
The Premier League has been renamed State Playing League with Vicki Wagner as chair.
The application deadline is May 15 however too many teams have applied already. How to pick the qualifying teams will be decided after State Cup.

5.3. Tournaments

The 99/00 tournament calendar was handed to all league presidents or their representatives. Leagues not represented at the meeting will receive the calendar by mail. It is rumored that the calendar will shortly be available on the CYSA-N web site.

5.4. C3PL

The next C3PL meeting will be at 7:30 on May 12 at Cambrian District Office, Jackson St.
The youngest age group will be U9.

5.5. Coaching

SSJ League is hosting an E/D license class May 7. Need more signups. Call: David Kilmar 408-578-3366.
Note that the District was successful in tracking last year's State Cup Red cards and that those red card recipients were prevented from playing. The same will happen for this year's red carded players in the 2000 State Cup.

5.6. Recreational Playing League - RPL

Leagues are encouraged to advertise the Recreational Playing League in their sign-up literature, web sites and school handouts.
Work on the RPL Bylaws is progressing.

5.7. State Cup

Sunnyvale, Almaden and De Anza all have teams in the quarterfinals at Morgan Hill this weekend.

5.8. Association Cup

The Association Cup no-show team from Palo Alto will be fined.

5.9. District Cup

There will be meeting in May. It was stated that the dates for next seasons District Cup have been approved.

A proposal that a separate tournament would be held for the top 2 teams in C3PL, Redwood class 3 league, Santa Cruz class 3 league and District Cup to decide the Association Cup qualifying teams was tabled. A suggestion that District Cup brackets should be seeded was also tabled.

5.10. Abronzino

Team rosters are required by July 15. Fees are undecided. Only U17-U19 will be required to play in Morgan Hill.

5.11. Communication

6. New Business

Paperwork that a League refuses to sign should be appealed to Jeff Stanga for action.

Team Manuals are expected in August

It was noted that De Anza is allowing teams coached and trained by the Silicon Valley Ambassadors to register through their league. Teams with paid trainers are not unusual, says Bob Joyce, De Anza President.

Coaches who consider they have evidence of poaching (written evidence is best) by coaches inside or outside their league should contact Jeff Stanga. Steve Belarmino thought that leagues have primary responsibility for educating their own coaches about the no-poaching rule.

7. James Eastwood and Renato Capobianco from the San Jose Clash described the April 29 symposium which will feature an in-depth analysis of the pre-game techniques used by the Clash.
